Domitille Kiger is an international keynote speaker and a skydiving world champion. For more than ten years she has organized large formation world records, where more than 200 skydivers from across the planet build a figure at 185 mph. Her keynote **Breaking Records, Building Teams** carries that protocol over to the performance of teams inside a company.

Domitille Kiger is an international keynote speaker, a two time skydiving world champion and the holder of 10 world records. She manages more than 200 skydivers from across the planet, where every team member carries shared ownership of the outcome. She has been doing this for more than 10 years, organizing large formation world records.

Her keynote **Breaking Records, Building Teams** answers a question every leader asks: how do you get teams to perform together. Her answer sits in one distinction, between fatal risks, which an organization has to eliminate, and vital risks, without which it stops progressing. TEDx speaker, named by Forbes among its 40 Women 2025, Knight of the French National Order of Merit. She works in English and in French.

Domitille Kiger is an international keynote speaker and a skydiving world champion. World champion in 2011 and 2012, European champion in 2011, French champion in 2008, 2009 and 2011, she holds 10 world records and more than 10,000 jumps.

Her field work is less spectacular than it sounds: it consists of getting people who do not speak the same language to work together, in an environment where speech is impossible and where the useful working time lasts 70 seconds. Manager of 200+ skydivers from across the planet, where every team member carries shared ownership of the outcome. She has been doing this for more than 10 years, organizing large formation world records.

Out of that experimentation came the **RECORD Protocol**, built around three pillars: the Flight Plan (structure), the Parachute (trust) and the Horizon (purpose). She carries it onto the stage in her keynote **Breaking Records, Building Teams**, which helps teams perform together by telling the risks that destroy from the risks that propel.

Co-founder of zerOGravity and AUDEO, board member of the French Skydiving Federation and chair of the Skydiving for the Disabled committee at the international commission, she speaks more than 30 times a year in front of executive committees and teams, from luxury to pharma, from tech to banking. TEDx speaker, named by Forbes among its 40 Women 2025, Knight of the French National Order of Merit. She is writing a book, *Fatal / Vital*, out in 2027. She works in English and in French.

## Approved wording

## TO AVOID

## Wording outside the positioning

- **“Motivational speaker”, “inspirational keynote”.** The subject is a protocol for collective performance, not an inspirational talk.
- **“Female empowerment”, “women supporting women”, “fulfilment”.** These angles come from older fact sheets and no longer match the positioning.
- **“Freefly champion”, “two time freefly champion”.** The exact title is skydiving world champion.
